### TIPS FOR VIEWING THIS PRESENTATION:

## Whole-House Stereo Speaker Cable Installation



Our standard installation is a quality double-shielded 16-Gauge four lead speaker cable. We pull one cable, which carries left and right channel stereo from the location of your **Stereo Amplifier** to the location of our **Electronic Distribution Panel**.



We pull a speaker cable with left and right channel stereo across the house through the attic or under the floor joist. It is dropped at a single in-wall J-box to connect up to a volume control device, which will be installed later.



Occasionally it is convenient to locate two volume controls in the same location. A **good example** would be a volume control in the kitchen and the volume control for the outside speakers at the same location.



We pull a two lead speaker cable carrying both left and right stereo music from the wall mounted volume control to each speaker of a set installed in each zone.
